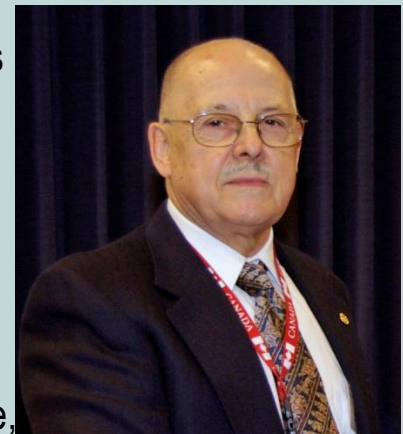

Smaller Localities across Eastern Canada

The “Smaller Localities” talk begins with a scattering of quarries in the Siliurian Lockport dolomite of Niagara Falls, then proceeds east to a Precambrian outcrop with högbomite and corundum, on to Montreal and the Francon quarry, then the South Ham antimony mine, and east again to boron deposits in New Brunswick (volkovskite, penobsquisite, etc—not a “collecting” locality), and finally a quick look at the zeolites and calcite on the Bay of Fundy.
